WHAREKAUHAU FARM TOUR

\$185.00 per person

This working sheep station tour - in a comfortable 4-wheel drive vehicle - is an absolute must for all Wharekauhau Visitors. Bordered by the Rimutaka Ranges and Pacific Ocean, this classic Kiwi Romney sheep station features all the activities that have created New Zealand's legendary farming heritage, including sheep shearing demonstrations, sheep dogs in action and daily farm events.

Notes:

- Departs the lodge at **9.30am** and returns approximately 12.30pm
- Max guests per vehicle is 6.
- Complimentary for a three night stay or more
- Features Sheep Shearing, Farm Dogs Working & Wharekauhau History, feeding wild eels. **Please note** that being a working farm there are occasions where the farm manager may not be able to complete the sheep shearing or dogs working the sheep. During the peak farming months of July, August and September (lambing season) there is no sheep shearing, however there is the opportunity to hand feed one of our new born lambs

SEAL COLONY AND CAPE PALLISER TOUR

Travel along the rugged coastline to the picturesque, historic fishing village of Ngawi, looking back over Palliser Bay to Wharekauhau. Continue on to one of New Zealand's largest Brown Fur Seal colonies where seals bask in this unspoiled natural environment. Whilst there, climb to the top of the lighthouse for magnificent views. On return, stop at the historical Lake Ferry Hotel for famous fish and chips and some local beverages from the southernmost tip of the North Island.

Your guide will chauffeur you around the best vineyards and introduce you to the wine-makers for a deeper insight into the local wine scene. Included with this tour will be lunch at one of the vineyard cafes or at one of the excellent cafes in the village where you will also have the opportunity to visit the boutique shops.

Soil+Barrel+Cellar+Passion Wine Experience

Three of the biggest influences in great wines combine in a one day tour. Look, see, smell, touch, and most importantly taste the influence that, the soil, the barrels, the vintage and the passion have over our tiny region. The Martinborough wine region has been growing vines for about 30 years. A young region by comparison globally, but one of the oldest in the New Zealand wine world. Enjoy the rare opportunity to get passed the cellar door and into the private cellars of some of the craftsmen of our region.

Without giving all of our secrets away some of the highlights of the day out would include; A walk through the award winning Devotus Estate; Drawing samples straight from the barrel and tasting the wine before it even hits the bottle; A trip into the private cellar of the famous Martinborough Vineyards to sample some of the older vintages from the region; and a few other 'hidden gems' of the region.

CLAY TARGET SHOOTING - Advanced

Designed for the experienced shooter, or those wishing to step up from an introduction to sporting clays. We start with some classic down-the-line shooting at the southern- plateau, before moving north and shooting the various sporting traps, including a session at the newly-opened 'Foleys-Flyer' trap. Then finishing with the challenging rolling 'rabbit' trap.

- Cost covers 75 clays, \$3 per clay after that
- 410 shotgun, and 12 gauge shotguns are available
- Firearms, ammunition, targets and instruction are provided
- Typically this activity takes around 2-2.5 hours to complete.
- Intended for 14 years and over

ARCHERY

The ancient sport of archery has enjoyed a resurgence in popularity on the back of The Lord of the Rings and Hobbit films. Full instruction and a range of archery targets, such as 3D targets, traditional boards, and balloons are available at Wharekauhau
